Tactile, multi-sensory interpretations of Harper's iconic posters representing the featured habitats.

Woodland Ball Run

Playful discovery game of hide & seek with different animals and insects found in the woods.

Ocean Races

Mechanical race through the ocean with different aquatic creatures navigating their environment.

Be Wild Imagination Habitat

Immersive interpretation of Harper's habitats with room to 'be wild' like your favorite creatures.

Art Studio

Engaging art making activities that emulate Harper's practice and minimal realistic style.

Art Gallery


Curated collection of giclee prints representing the key pieces of Harper's body of work.
